This skill enhancement course aims to enhance communicative skills in Hindi language, enabling participants to attain fluency and proficiency in spoken and written Hindi.



DEPARTMENT OF HINDI Course Options

Semester I

ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSES (AEC)
HINDI EKANKI (UK1AECHIN100)

The course explores the development of One Act Plays in Hindi, enabling students to appreciate the literary form and address contemporary issues through selected plays.

HINDI KAHANI (UK1AECHIN101)

The course introduces short stories, enables story appreciation, and fosters creativity and cognitive development in students.

HINDI KAVITA (UK1AECHIN102)

The course familiarizes students with Hindi poetry, develops an eye for appreciation and enhances creative skills, and language competency.

MULTIDISCIPLINARY COURSE (MDC)

MEETHI HINDI (UK1MDCHIN100)

This course develops proficiency in Hindi for effective communication, by focusing on speaking, reading, writing, vocabulary, grammar, and cultural nuances through interactive activities and practical exercises.

Semester II

ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSES (AEC)

HINDI SANRACHNA AUR WEB LEKHAN (UK2AECHIN100)

This course teaches proper use of Hindi through grammar mastery. It utilizes translation as a tool for teaching effective communication. It enables application of Hindi language skills in web writing.

VYAVAHARIK HINDI (UK2AECHIN102)

This course provides insight into the regular use of technical terms in Hindi. It explores the influence of Hindi in society and how technical terms relate to specific social and occupational groups.

HINDI CINEMA (UK2AECHIN103)

This course delves into the brief history of Hindi cinema, comparing movies historically and technically. It explores the development of Hindi cinema, evaluates notable figures' contributions, and analyzes classic films while offering experimental knowledge on adaptation.

MULTIDISCIPLINARY COURSE (MDC)

HINDI FILMI GEET (UK2MDCHIN101)

This course aims to foster understanding and analytical thinking about various elements of Hindi film songs. It utilizes film songs as a tool to enhance language proficiency and comprehension.
