

In association with the "New India at 75 campaigns "Programme Officer attended the meeting with District Collector and other officials on 28th September, 2021 at 2.45 pm.

A Whatsapp group for Red Ribbon Club was started at the college level with the Pricncipal and Student members to co-ordinate RRC activities as per the instructions of the District Collector.

District Medical Office (Health) Thiruvananthapuram in association with NACO/KSACS had conducted an online orientation session about Voluntary Blood Donation for School and College Students as part of New India@75 Campaign on 1.10.2021 from 11.00 AM to 12 PM. Resource person was Dr Mary Aloysius, Senior Consultant, General Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram.



In association with National Voluntary Blood Donation Day, Speech contest and Cartoon drawing contest was held at the college on October 9, 2021 on the basis of the theme: "Voluntary Blood Donation". Aditya S A from MA Sociology was selected as the winner.



As part of the celebrations of the 75th anniversary of independence (New India at 75), the group launched a blood donation awareness program for children at nearby schools.

On November 10, a college-level online quiz competition was conducted to select two students to compete on behalf of our College in the District-Level Quiz Competition on AIDS awareness. Akhil S.G (BA Physics) and Amal. A.L (MA Sociology) won the first and second prizes respectively and these selected students participated in the district-level quiz competition held on November 10, at, Government Hospital, Thycaud under the guidance of the Program Officer. Our College team won the Third prize in the competition.





For celebrating WORLD AIDS DAY, College-level quiz competition was conducted on November 30, 2021. There were 9 teams from the college. After the final round, Feba Alexander and Team from 2nd year BA Sociology won first prize and two other teams – one from Maths Department and the other from Physics department scored equal marks winning the second prize. The first prize was 1000 rupees cash prize and second prize was 500 rupees cash prize awarded to each team. Certificates were distributed to all the participating team members.





RRC at Govt. KNM College also organised an Intercollegiate Poster Design competition and Short video contest as part of World AIDS Day celebrations. The date for submitting videos was extended from November 30 to December 10. On 17th December winner of the short video contest was announced. First prize was awarded to the video submitted by Asha mol, Christy Chacko, Bibin Joseph from Assumption College, Changanacherry. Second prize went to Harishankar, Ajini, and Abhinav from Sreekrishna College, Guruvayur. Cash Prize and certificates were distributed to the winners.



Students from GKNM College Kanjiramkulam participated in the short film competition held in January 2022 organised by KSCAS and National AIDS Control Society. The entry submitted was directed by Adithya S.A and Anjana V.S. Student volunteers acted in the short film that was meant to eradicate social stigma against AIDS patients.
