## Report of Pride Quiz 2022

# Inauguration

Quiz Club, Govt. K. N. M. Arts and Science College in association with Gender Justice Forum and Inclusion Cell conducted Pride Quiz 2022 as part of Pride Month celebrations on 28/06/2022 at 11 am. The quiz was preceded by a short function in which Vivek V. S., the day's quiz master and coordinator of the Quiz Club, welcomed the gathering. Dr R. Krishna Kumar, Principal-in-charge, made the inaugural address in which he spoke about the importance of organising such programmes which promotes awareness about the marginalised sections of our society. Dr Chithra S. Nair, convenor of Gender Justice Forum and Inclusion Cell also spoke on the occasion about how it is more important to participate in such programmes than win prizes.

### The Quiz

The inaugural function was immediately followed by the competition. Since student participation was given primary importance all the registered teams were given the opportunity to take part and so a preliminary screening round was done away with. Fifteen teams of two members each from different departments of the college took part. The quiz master prepared a PowerPoint presentation comprising twelve questions with two extra tie-breaker questions. The quiz was carefully structured as to include questions pertaining to Pride history, government policies, law, sports, religion and LGBTQIA+ personalities. The visual element in the questions kept the participants as well as the audience engaged.

2. First openly homosexual Indian athlete.


Current national record holder for 100m.



#### **Prizes**

The quiz was designed to render the LGBTQIA+ community familiar, to make them visible, to prove that they are as human as one can be. The feedback received from the students and faculty was exceedingly positive with many suggesting that such programmes be conducted more often.
